The Cologne AIT-ArchitekturSalon will continue to be the home of the international 'Interior Scholarship'. This is the AIT Scholarship of the Sto Foundation, which aims to support talented interior design students in such a way that they are able to exclusively dedicate themselves to their studies and to their professional as well as personal development.

For meanwhile more than 123 years, AIT has been focusing on the "interior of architecture" - and that is why AIT also feels responsible for the future generation of interior architects. Therefore, two scholarships will therefore be awarded in 2013. Interior design students from Germany and abroad are entitled to apply. For one year, two scholars will receive 900 Euros per month.

It is, of course, obvious that the gallery in Cologne of all venues was selected as the home of the scholarship. With the Cologne Furniture Fair and the PASSAGEN, the metropolis on the Rhine is one of the international centres for interior design and interior decoration. Where else could a better public platform be offered to the scholars? Among other benefits, the interior design students subsidised by AIT and Sto Foundation will be given the opportunity to present themselves with their own exhibition in a special area of the Cologne AIT-ArchitekturSalon - and this will, of course, take place in the context of the PASSAGEN during the Cologne Furniture Fair 2014.

The scholarships are financed by the Sto Foundation which has made it its aim to support the "education of the young generation ... as an investment in the future of our society". That is why Sto Foundation encourages young people in their academic education. The overriding purpose of Sto Foundation takes up the leitmotif of "Building with Conscience" of Sto AG. The founder has set itself the objective of global technological leadership in the economic sector in favour of a humane and sustainable design of our built living environment.

Applications may be submitted by all students specialising in interior design (or comparable courses of study such as interior decoration etc.) who are enrolled at a European university and are at least in their 4th semester. The jury deciding on the selection of the scholars consists of a representative of the Sto Foundation
